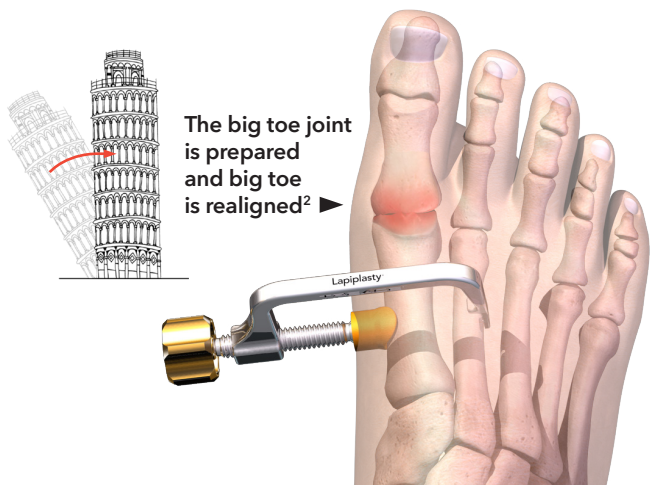

## How it works

### First-

The bone surfaces are prepared and advanced instrumentation is designed to straighten the big toe, repositioning the 3D alignment of the joint<sup>2</sup>.



### **An arthrodesis (fusion) of the big toe joint using Lapiplasty<sup>®</sup> technology:**

- ✓ Gets you back on your feet in a boot, in some cases, within 1-2 weeks<sup>1</sup>
- ✓ Designed to straighten the big toe and reposition the 3D alignment of the big toe joint<sup>2</sup>
- ✓ Utilizes patented Lapiplasty<sup>®</sup> fixation technology to secure the joint

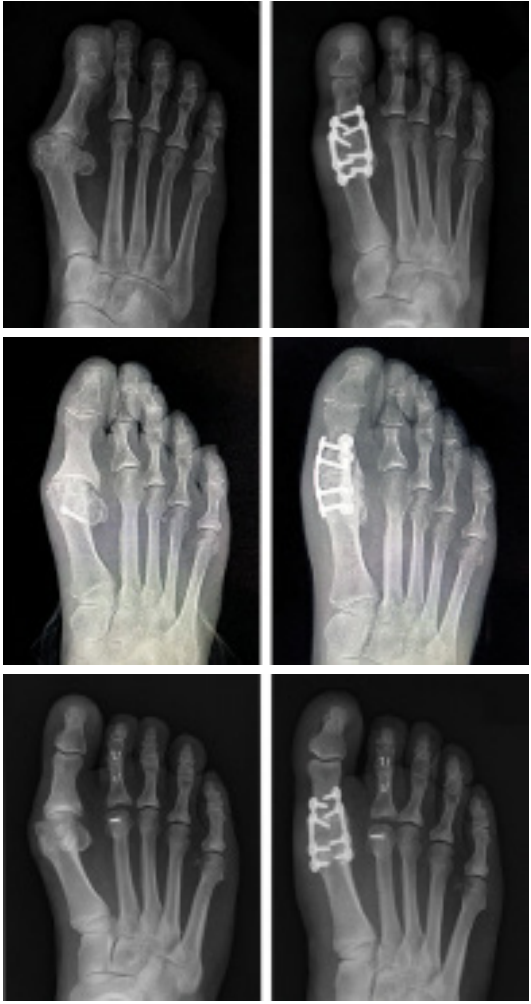
